

## Feathertop Sauvignon Blanc 2009



Pristine white labels and the Feathertop name - it's a good introduction to a sauvignon blanc. The opening line of the back label says - "Often sauvignon blanc's are too pungent and vegetative for my liking, especially some of the fruit bombs coming from NZ". They call it as they see it in the Alpine Valleys.

The wine itself is pretty decent. Not overly intense, but flavorsome enough. Passionfruit with licks of tropical fruit, a gentle (dry) grassiness and a fresh, tangy finish. Good drinking, for sure. Aftertaste has a gentle smokiness (not smoke taint) which I like too.
