

Feathertop Pinot Gris 2009



Feathertop Pinot Gris is grown in the Alpine Valleys in north-east Victoria. Indeed the vineyard is running distance from where I live...and I'm not a great runner. I've lived in the area for nearly six years and this, I think, is the first time I've reviewed a Feathertop (formerly known as Boynton's) wine.

It's a racy version of pinot gris. There's some rich, textural flavor on the finish but for the most part it's spritely, almost citrusy. Notes of nectarine-bordering-on-the-honeysuckle and a general spiciness. It's definitely a 'gris' style but it keeps things crisp. A nice wine.
