CURRENT WINE LIST

Feathertop Riesling 2008

The 2008 Riesling is again quite dry in my usual style and holds loads of lemony and lime flavours – they linger in your mouth for what seems like an eternity. You will notice that we have made credit to our lovely Rose whom many of you will have met in cellar door. Her favourite wine is our Riesling and let's just say, at the end of day any left over Riesling tasting bottles are never around long! A good way to clock off the day while counting the till! So this wine is for her.

Feathertop Sauvignon Blanc 2009

Often Sauvignon Blanc's are too pungent & vegetative for my liking, especially some of the fruit bombs coming from NZ. One sniff & sip is wonderful, one glass, too much. This cool climate Sauvignon Blanc has none of the aromas in it, instead it is blessed with subtle tropical fruit aromas & flavours with a twist of fresh lime running through it. Drink before, during & after meals.

Feathertop Pinot Gris 2009

After tasting my first Pinot Gris whilst working at a winery in Alsace, France, it has taken me almost 30 years to be able to reproduce this wine experience off my own vineyard. The 2009 vintage was cooler than normal giving the wine more fruit aromas of honeysuckle & white nectarine & flavours including juicy citrus. It is racy, dry & crisp. A great food wine.

Feathertop Chardonnay 2006

This wine's aroma has hints of nectarines, white peaches and a touch of fennel while the flavours are fresh and clean featuring cleansing lime and grapefruit with a touch of oak. It is not your typical Australian oaky and buttery Chardonnay.

Feathertop May Harvest 2008

Every so often, we in the Alpine Valleys are blessed with a long and dry summer which permits the making of this sweeter than usual wine from the ripest white grapes in the vineyard. This particular vintage has been made from Chardonnay, Semillon and Riesling.

Feathertop Merlot 2008

The 08 vintage is quite aromatic with lifted floral notes of violets, blackcurrants, blackberry on top of dark chocolate and a touch of mint. The flavours follow the aromas of dark berries and the palate is rounded and relatively soft with adequate fine tannins to give the wine length and longevity. The marriage of the Alpine Valley terroir and the variety Merlot is quite outstanding.

Feathertop Shiraz 2008

Our vineyard is definitely a sustainable & cool vineyard needing zero irrigation or artificial fertilizers. With roots deeply embedded in ancient alluvial soils the grapes produce powerful flavours, smooth tannins & a structure that can age beautifully. A small percentage of Durif & Viognier has been blended for reasons perfectly clear to me, the winemaker.

Feathertop Cabernet Sauvignon 2005

Our Cabernet Sauvignon grows naturally without irrigation in extremely deep red loam. For 20 years these vines have produced wines with a richness of ripe, dark berry fruit aromas, flavours and wonderful fine tannins. After two and a half years in American and French oak barriques. The 2005 vintage is a great wine drinking really well now but my guess it will continue to improve over the next 10 – 15 years.

Alluvium 2001

80% Cabernet, 12% Merlot, 8% Petit Verdot Alluvium derives its name from the soil types that it is grown on. Like the soils the wine is deep in colour, rich and complex. Cabernet provides the framework (bones), Merlot the meat, Petit Verdot the muscle tone. Only the best barriques & best years are accepted into this flagship wine; hence in some years it is not made at all!

Terraces 2001

92% Shiraz, 8% Petite Syrah (Durif) Waterborne deposits of stone, gravel and soil have formed mini plateaux - Terraces. Shiraz and Petite Syrah grow fabulously well in this terroir, always ripening earlier with higher concentration of colour, tannin and sugar, Great wine!

Winner of a silver medal at the International Wine and Spirits Show in London UK.

Feathertop Blush 2007

A beautiful fresh, vibrant and dry Sparkling made from our Durif grapes. Who would have thought this black grape variety could produce a wine with such a beautiful delicate pink blush and an unbelievably elegant palate. A wine I am intensely proud of.

Feathertop Prosecco 2008

Fun, fruity, but dry & serious. I love this wine, whenever, wherever & with whomever. Made from Prosecco & Chardonnay. As time goes on there will be less Chardonnay in this Sparkling wine. I hope you enjoy it as much as Janelle, the staff and I do.

Feathertop Tawny NV Port 15 years old (500ml)

An aged tawny style port which has a vast and loyal following. Smooth nutty, rancio characters and matured fruit flavours lend complexity to this extremely drinkable port. A delightful way to finish off a good meal at any time of the year, and an essential for those nights when it comes in frosty.

Lush

On a rowing trip to Seville, Spain, I visited Osborne cellars in Jerez and was given a wonderful tour of their Celleros and a tasting of their famous wines. I distinctly remember tasting the very old and luscious Pedro Ximenez (P.X.) Several years later I was presented with a rare parcel of very ripe and partially raisined grapes suitable for making such a wine. I called it Lush because it was.

Gold 2008

This is a 'Sticky' or dessert wine made from botrytised Chardonnay, Riesling and Semillon grapes. Botrytis, known in Germany as 'Noble Rot', is not always that Noble, but when the weather conditions are right it feeds off the moisture in the grapes and partially raisins them, making what is left of the juice very noble indeed. This wine is a result of such a year and can be enjoyed with desserts and cheeses.

Summit Cru
